Bad Memorandum dated 21 December 1874, from the Hon. the Provincial Secretary reporting that a petition from the inhabitants of Nanaimo, has been addressed to your Excellency, in conformity with the provisions of the Municipality Act, 1872 and the Municipality Act, Amendments, praying that the town of Nanaimo, and the townsite of Newcastle, be created into a Municipality in accordance with the Act in that behalf.

The Provincial Secretary recommends that the prayer be granted.

The Committee advise that the recommendation be approved, and that your Excellency be pleased to direct the issue of Letters Patent incorporating the inhabitants of Nanaimo & Newcastle with a Municipality to be called "the Corporation of the City of Nanaimo".
