

PROCLAMATION PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS MONTH SEPTEMBER/2014

WHEREAS: prostate cancer is the most common cancer among Canadian men; and

WHEREAS: 1 in 8 men will be diagnosed with the disease during his lifetime; and

WHEREAS: an estimated 23,600 Canadian men will be diagnosed with prostate cancer this

year; and

WHEREAS: the survival rate for prostate cancer can be over 90% when detected early; and

WHEREAS: those with a family history of the disease or those of African or Caribbean

descent are at a greater risk of getting prostate cancer; and

WHEREAS: Prostate Cancer Canada recommends that men get a PSA test in their 40s to

establish their baseline.

NOW THEREFORE I, John Ruttan, Mayor of the City of Nanaimo, do hereby proclaim that the month of September/2014 shall be known as:

'PROSTATE CANCER AWARENESS MONTH'
