

PROCLAMATION


NATIONAL INDIGENOUS PEOPLE'S DAY JUNE 21, 2020

- WHEREAS: the City of Nanaimo believes that it is beneficial for all Canadians to recognize the contributions of the Metis, Inuit and First Nations in Canada's development; and
