



Midtown Gateway project reaches major milestone

A section of the new roadway will soon be open for use, connecting Northfield to Rosstown Road

Summary

While construction continues on the Midtown Gateway Project, a major milestone has been reached. On September 25, a new section of Boxwood Road and the new Powder Works Road (connecting Northfield Road to Rosstown Road) is set to open to vehicle traffic, cyclists, pedestrians and the #30 bus.

Powder Works Road will now replace the Bowen and Rosstown intersection as the new access point for Rosstown Road. Drivers will have a week to adjust their commute and get used to the new streets; access to Rosstown Road from Bowen Road will be permanently closed starting Tuesday, October 1 at 10 a.m.

On September 25, RDN Transit #30 NRGH will reroute and buses will travel between Rosstown Road and Meredith Road via Powder Works Road and Boxwood Road. Affected transit users should refer to <u>the new Rider's</u> <u>Guide</u> on the RDN Transit website.

Construction on the Midtown Gateway Project is expected to continue until next summer. This includes upgrades to the intersection of Bowen and Northfield Road, a new multi-use path on Boxwood Road, and a new traffic-signal-controlled intersection on Bowen Road opening later this fall, which will also serve as an enhanced access into Beban Park.
