EXTENSION ROAD TRAFFIC CALMING

CINNABAR/FLAGSTONE TO CRANBERRY



Copcan Civil LP, working on behalf of the City of Nanaimo is scheduled to begin construction in your area starting June, and completing by the end of July 2024.

Typical construction hours will be 7am - 5pm, Monday to Friday. In the work zones, there will be single lane alternating traffic. There will be at least one day with a closure between Cinnabar Drive and Richardson Road with a detour when the asphalt speed bump is installed.

The Contractor will begin at the south end and there could be delays for those accessing Cinnabar Elementary School. The pedestrian crossing improvements by Cranberry Avenue, near Chase River Elementary, are expected to begin in July after the end of the school year.



Work by Copcan Civil includes:

- Center concrete medians at Cinnabar Road,
- Center pedestrian refuge in medians at crossings at Cowling Place and Cranberry Avenue,
- In-Crosswalk 'Yield to Pedestrian' Sign at Richardson Road and Roberta Road West,
- A speed bump between Cinnabar Drive and Richardson Road,
- White painted lane lines,
- Bus stop improvements. Check Regional District Nanaimo Transit for temporary bus stops.

Work by Daeco Installations includes:

- Digital Speed Reader at 3 locations,
- Add pedestrian activated RRFB (Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacons) at Cowling Place,
- Upgrade existing RRFB Flashers at Richardson Road and add an extension arm at Roberta Road West
