

WHAT'S NEXT?

The watermain south of Bastion Street was connected to the network last week and the services to each building were switched over to the new main. Now that the old watermain has been taken out of service south of Bastion Street, excavation for the soil cells on the west side of Commercial Street can begin.

First, the back-filling will be completed on the east side of Commercial Street and a temporary sidewalk will be constructed to facilitate continued, uninterrupted access for pedestrians.
