With Bastion Street now closed to vehicle traffic between Skinner Street and Adam Grant Horne Lane, the drilling and grouting work for the mine voids has begun.

The boreholes that have been drilled so far have given the team the opportunity to collect videos of the underground conditions. Early results have been promising and show mostly areas of loose rubble rather than large open voids.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK:

When will the Phase 1 construction work be completed? Will the Night Market be affected?

Construction is expected to be substantially complete in May of this year, with some cleanup and low impact work taking place in June (landscaping for example).

The Night Market opening date is not expected to be impacted.

UPCOMING WORK

Drilling and grouting on Bastion Street will be continuing for the next several weeks.

Excavation for the soil cells on the west side of Commercial Street, south of Bastion began this week and will continue. Soil cell installation is scheduled for next week.

While the soil cell installer is working south of Bastion Street, Windley Contracting is planning on continuing with excavations for some of the pocket soil cells north of Bastion Street.



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
